	honorable discharge and the federal DD214 served in at
	least one of the following Operations: Enduring
	Freedom, Noble Eagle, Iraqi Freedom, Nomad
	Shadow, New Dawn, Inherent Resolve, Freedom's
	Sentinel, and Odyssey Lightning.

NOTE: An honorable discharge is a mandatory requirement for any New Jersey state award.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: Complete and sign application on front side of this form.

## DO NOT SEND ORIGINALS but copies of the following:

- Proof of residency (Any document showing name and home address)
- DD Form 214 indicating "honorable discharge"
- Evidence of active duty service in qualifying areas or contiguous waters or airspace
- Copy of Death Certificate for posthumous awards
- Evidence of status as POW or MIA
